

Budget Guide – Far East (Bali, Hong Kong & Singapore)

In order to assist in budgeting for a Far East holiday, here is a listing of approximate prices. Please note, however, that these prices will vary depending on the star grading of the venue, city/town and season of travel.

BALI

HONG KONG

Cup of coffee in a café	HKD 30-40
Soft Drink	HKD 10 - 12
Mineral Water	HKD 7 - 10

SINGAPORE

2 Course Meal / Mid Range Restaurant	SGD 35 – 80
Big Mac at McDonalds or Similar	SGD 5 – 7
Local Beer at a hawker centre	SGD 7 – 12
Imported beer mid-range restaurant	SGD 12 – 25
Local beer in a trendy bar / restaurant	SGD 12 - 25
Local wine	SGD 15 – 25 per glass
Imported wine	SGD 65 - 120 per bottle
Cappuccino (regular)	SGD 6 – 8
Coke/Pepsi (0.33 litre bottle)	SGD 4 - 6
